They started their married life at Sandy in Blanco County where Chapman farmed and worked as a blacksmith.

To this union were born three children while the family lived at Sandy. Children: Duard Lester, James Ray, and Lorena Pearl.

Duard married Beatrice Kinsey in Arizona and had three sons: Wayne Ray, D.L., and Neal. He lived in Austin and later moved to California.

Ray married Vera Walker, to whom were born three sons and a daughter, Jimmie Ray, Walker, Royce, and Nancy. Most of their lives were spent in the Corpus Christi area.
